The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	Ward based work with variety of patients with respiratory (and often several other) problems. Regular on-call duties based in A&E and GP referral area. Plenty of opportunity to be active team member and regularly undertake histories, examinations, formulate management plans, initiate investigations, and undertake practical skills. Plenty of support from senior colleagues. Formal training opportunities • Weekly foundation programme teaching • Departmental teaching • 4 days of self-development time per rotation

Supervisor(s) for the placement	To be decided upon commencement
Main duties of the placement	Ensure hand over lists are regularly updated. Attend morning and evening handover daily. Present on daily ward round ensuring notes are up to date and changes to management or need for investigations are implemented. Chasing up investigation results.
Typical working pattern in this placement	Daily ward round every morning. Ward based jobs take much of the afternoon. Attend weekly departmental meetings. On-call duties. Limited opportunity to attend clinic due to busy nature of job. Opportunity to partake in quality improvement projects.
